


The RB19 container is used by Recolight at collection points for the safe storage of waste Gas Discharge Lamps. The container is normally delivered flat packed. It is important that when the container is received onsite, it is assembled in the correct way. This is to ensure all safety and security features are fully functional when in use.


Use the check list above. If you are missing a part, please contact info@recolight.co.uk immediately and do not attempt to assemble the container until you have received all the parts.


To assemble:


- 1**
Unlock lid (x4)



- 2**
Remove lid and place to the side – two people required



- 3**
Put sleeve upright and slot into return collar



- 4**
Push sleeve into track on the base of the container


- 5**
Lock sleeve to pallet (x4) using the lock tabs at the base of the container. Return collar may already be attached. If not, clip in with sleeve. This will avoid bulging of sleeve


- 6**
Fold flaps on base tray and place inside container to line the base.


- 7**
Place lid on container (2 people required)


- 8**
Lock lid (x4) and secure









Assembly And Handling Guide

Gas Discharge Lamps contain mercury, a hazardous substance, which if smashed can release mercury into the environment. Waste lamps pending collection must always be stored securely, stacked correctly and free from breakage.

The following instructions for the RB19 container must be followed. And remember:

- Do not place broken lamps in the container
- Secure container when not in use
- Stack lamps neatly
- Containers are for lamps only, and not lamp packaging

Loading instruction:

<p>1</p> <p>Open lid</p>		<p>2</p> <p>Open loading door</p>	
<p>3</p> <p>Ready for loading – place lamps neatly in container</p>		<p>4</p> <p>Close loading door, ensuring tabs are secured</p>	
<p>5</p> <p>Close and secure lid with locking tabs x4</p>		<p>6</p> <p>Container closed</p>	
<p>7</p> <p>Do not exceed filling line</p>		<p>8</p> <p>Correct storage shown</p>
