Recolight was set up by the lighting industry in 2005 to take on their WEEE responsibility for recycling when the WEEE Regulations were introduced into the UK.

- Operating as a not for profit Producer Compliance Scheme, Recolight provides free recycling for our Members and their end users.
- We can provide this as a FREE recycling service because we are funded by our Members, the lighting industry.
- We are the leading WEEE compliance scheme in the UK specialising in all lighting in scope of the WEEE Regulations.

## Free lamp recycling


- We provide an efficient and cost effective process for recycling waste lamps, in compliance with the WEEE Regulations.
- We collect all WEEE lighting in scope of the WEEE Regulations.
- We have a dedicated customer service team offering help and support to all our Recolight collection points.
- Recoweb, our online booking system, makes it easy to book a collection and complete consignment notes too.

### The recycling process

The WEEE Regulations set a target of 80% for recovery rates during recycling – this is the percentage of materials that can be reused from the waste lamps after recycling. The Recolight recycling recovery rate is over 90%.

# **Our FREE recycling services**

#### **FOR LAMPS**

#### **Service Option 1**

#### More than 1000 lamps in 3 months

- We can provide you with a container, free of charge and recycle your lamps free of charge too.
- If you are a wholesaler, you can choose to have an open collection point for all your customers.
- Open collection points are added to our collection point map, for new customers to find you too.

#### Service option 2

#### Less than 1000 lamps in 3 months

- You can lease a Recolight container.
- · Collection and recycling is free.
- You will be added to Recoweb, our online booking system.

#### Service option 3

#### One off - Adhoc collections

For relamping projects and sites that do not generate regular large quantities of lamps:

- We provide one off collections for quantities of over 1000 lamps.
- We provide containers on a short term lease.

#### Small quantities of waste lamps

- We have a network of drop off points for lamps. These are located at electrical wholsalers across the UK.
- Have a look at the map on our website to find the one closest to you.
- You must always call the contact number listed for the collection point to check they have space for your lamps!

# FOR BATTERIES AND ELECTRICAL ITEMS

Recolight offer a recycling service for batteries and other electrical items. Operating as a not-for-profit organisation, we can do this at a low cast, competitive service.

#### Helping you stay compliant

There are environmental, health and safety regulations with which you must comply. This is to control the risks associated with the storage and movement of hazardous waste.

On our website you'll find guidance to help you stay compliant. Our pages for storing and moving waste lamps talk you through all that is required from all UK Environment Agencies. We also have advice to help you complete consignment notes and your risk assessment.





### Your Compliance Checklist

- Licenses If you move waste lamps for your customers in England & Wales you'll need a licence
  - In Scotland and Northern Ireland, you simply notify your Environment Agency.
- Hazardous waste premises
  code required for sites
  in Wales producing more
  than 500kg of hazardous
  waste in twelve months.
- Exemptions in Scotland and Northern Ireland you will need to notify your Environment Agency to allow you to store waste lamps.
- Consignment notes –
  used to track movement of
  hazardous waste in the UK
  You must keep copies for
  three years.
- Consignee Returns to be completed quarterly by all sites in England & Wales receiving waste lamps.
