Why Recolight is different

Not-for-profit

Recolight is a not-for-profit compliance scheme. This allows us to focus solely on making recycling of lighting easy and keeping our core charges to our Members as low as possible. Our size and financial strength means we are excellently placed to handle the changes in the lamp and luminaire recycling which will apply in future years.

We recycle WEEE lighting


Most UK WEEE schemes with a lighting obligation meet their targets by buying "evidence notes" from recyclers, or other schemes. Evidence notes are certificates that confirm a quantity of waste has been recycled.

At Recolight, we do things differently. It is our objective to meet our targets entirely by directly organising the collection and recycling of waste. That means we can offer a free collection and recycling service to you, and your customers. You, and your customers, can directly benefit from the Recolight service – and at the same time we use that waste to meet our targets. It also means we have full duty of care traceability – we know exactly where the waste we recycle has come from.

41,000 tonnes recycled

To date, Recolight has funded the collection and recycling of over 41,000 tonnes of lamps, LEDs and luminaires.

This achievement means that Recolight, together with our collection points and Producer Members, has been responsible for recycling more WEEE lighting products than all other UK compliance schemes put together.

Recycling of lamps from business sources

Recolight has established a unique network of over 2,000 commercial collection points to collect and recycle waste lamps from business end users. They are located at wholesalers, contractors, facility management companies and end user sites.

Dedicated open network

Recolight is the only WEEE compliance scheme in the UK with a dedicated open collection point network for consumer and business waste lamps and LEDs.

Additionally, we have a network of over 60 open collection points for luminaires.

Lobbying to get the WEEE Regulations right

Recolight is active in lobbying to ensure that the WEEE regulations and associated legislation are right for the UK lighting industry and its customers. We successfully lobbied to get the hazardous waste regulations amended - allowing collection points to store waste for longer before it needs to be collected. We also lobby at a UK and European level to ensure that collection targets are correct, and that changes to the WEEE regulations are implemented in a way that is appropriate for lighting equipment Producers.

Eucolight

Recolight is a founder member of EucoLight, an important new organisation for WEEE compliance schemes in Europe that focuses on WEEE lighting. Lighting schemes now have a face and voice in Brussels. EucoLight helps to ensure that any changes to WEEE legislation at EU level are right for the lighting industry.

Recolight's CEO, Nigel Harvey, is one of the five EucoLight board members. That means that Recolight is always at the forefront of legislative regulatory change for WEEE lighting.

Benefits to members' customers

Waste clearance for major LED luminaire roll-out projects

One of Recolight's fastest growing service is the large scale, multi-site service for the collection of the waste lamps, luminaires, and batteries (from emergency fittings) that arise when conventional luminaires are replaced by LED equivalents. Increasingly, the demands of corporate social responsibility mean that major specifiers require their luminaire suppliers to take responsibility for this waste. Recolight is the ideal partner to meet that need.

Free lamp recycling



Recolight provides free regular collections of waste lamps, helping members and their customers to recycle waste lamps as simply as possible. Collection containers can be provided free of charge and collection and recycling are also free.*

Recolight is the only compliance scheme that provides eligible business customers with:

- Free storage containers.
- Free collections and recycling.
- Dedicated customer service support team helping businesses comply with environmental regulations.

Customers of Recolight Members collecting a minimum of 1,000 lamps every three months can apply to join Recolight's collection point network. They can choose to become an open collection point, enabling them to pass on the benefits of free and convenient lamp collections to their own customers.

Collection & recycling options



We can provide a container for your customers' waste lamps at your site, or your distributor's site.



For regular large quantities of lamps, we can set up a free collection point at your customer's sites.



For a large refit project, we will lease a container, and collect it free of charge.



We also have a container lease option for smaller quantities of lamps, with free collection.



You can also send your customers to our nearest fully funded open collection point, using the collection point locator on our website.



We will also arrange collection and recycling of our members' obligated waste luminaires.




Why does it matter?

Offering free recycling increases recycling rates

Research has shown that three quarters of electrical contractors believe recycling rates would decline if they were required to pay for recycling when lamps reach end of life. That clearly means it is essential to offer a recycling service for the end user that is free at the point of use.

Recolight provides services in excess of the regulatory requirements to ensure lamp recycling is safe and efficient, and to help raise awareness of the importance of keeping lamps out of landfill. All lamps and luminaires collected go towards meeting the Recolight and national WEEE collection targets.



Protecting the environment



The WEEE regulations require producers of EEE and their compliance schemes to finance the treatment of WEEE. A large proportion of the UK lighting industry meet their producer obligations by being a Member of Recolight.
