The WEEE Regulations

The WEEE Regulations were introduced to the UK in 2007. Their purpose is to make sure Electronic and Electrical Equipment, EEE, is recycled, keeping this harmful waste stream from landfill.

Your duty of care requirements under WEEE Regulations

You have a legal requirement, and you have a duty of care to correctly dispose of hazardous waste, or hand it to a contractor who is authorised to handle it.

This applies to all who produce or store waste, collect and transport waste, or receive waste for recycling or disposal. All waste streams are required to be segregated.

Helping to reduce carbon emissions

The co-collection services for small mixed WEEE, lamps, luminaires, and batteries help reduce the carbon footprint by combining pickups into a single journey.

ReCOLlight are committed to reducing our carbon footprint. For this reason, waste is collected on request, only when you book, thus avoiding unnecessary trips. We may also provide multiple containers to distant and high-volume collection points, so that one vehicle movement can collect multiple containers.

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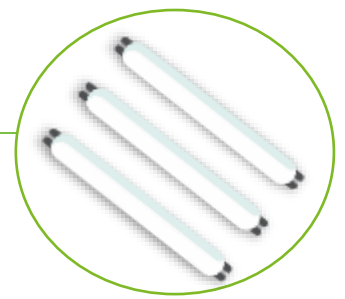

Please note: Special arrangements must be made for xenon waste lamps.

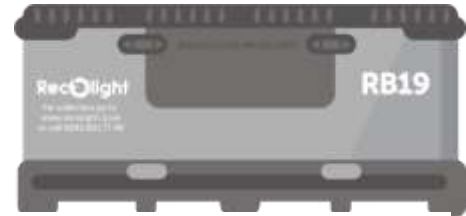

- ✓ Batteries must be removed from the fitting and placed in a battery drum
- ✓ Lamps must be removed and placed in your lamp container
- ✓ The rest of the luminaire must stay intact

Special instructions for battery storage

- ✓ Battery wires must be cut, and the ends taped, this is for your safety and all who handle them.
- ✓ Please look at the Recolight website for battery storage guidance.

The maximum gross weight of mixed batteries that can be collected is 333kg per collection. This weight includes containers, and any inert filling used.

If your collection might exceed 333kg, notify Recolight customer service, so that a solution can be considered, e.g., using specialist hauliers, or splitting them into multiple collections.

Non-hazardous WEEE

- Store on your own 1.2m x1.2m pallet & shrink wrap for collection
- Pallet to be no more than 1.2 m meters high
- Must NOT contain hazardous WEEE
- See below for container lease options of RPB pallet box

Hazardous WEEE

- Per item charges apply for hazardous WEEE collections
- Ask for a quotation in advance of requesting a collection

Batteries and lamps are collected separately

- ✓ Batteries must be removed from all electrical items.
- ✓ Lamps must be removed from all luminaires.

Mixing of hazardous waste is prohibited

Waste must be segregated with lamps, light fittings, and batteries stored in their own containers.

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Managing your waste

Whilst Recolight offer free collections across most of our services, this is subject to Recolight's terms and conditions.

Cost such as inaccessible, underweight, or contaminated containers must be passed on to you.

Costs are regularly reviewed, ensuring they are carefully calculated based on costs from suppliers.

Your check list

You can avoid charges if your containers are:

- ✓ Kept in a secure yard on a non-permeable surface
- ✓ Full on collection
- ✓ Used for just one waste stream Free of packaging or broken lamps
- ✓ Accessible and free from obstructions
- ✓ Waste must be segregated
- ✓ Lamps, light fittings, batteries and SMW stored in their own containers

When you book your collection tell us:

- ✓ Access restrictions to your site and site opening time
- ✓ All Information to help prevent a failed collection or delivery

The application and booking portal, [Recoweb](https://www.recoweb.co.uk) is designed for you to:

- ✓ Order new services - you can select from a variety of service options tailored to your specific waste types, volumes, and frequency needs. The system automatically calculates and suggests the best service package based on the information you provide
- ✓ Track and manage your waste collection by viewing the current status of bookings, and what has been requested
- ✓ Request specific fixed dates for waste collection to suit your schedules
- ✓ Receive automated email updates regarding changes in collection schedules or service updates
- ✓ You can view and download invoices for completed services. The system offers secure online payment options for all invoice
- ✓ Tonnage reports of waste collected, and electronic consignment notes can be provided, ensuring legal compliance for hazardous waste transport and disposal
